We have themed activities that change every year. In 2018, it was carnival based. There are performance and interactive workshop booked in for each week which ties in with the theme chosen for that year.



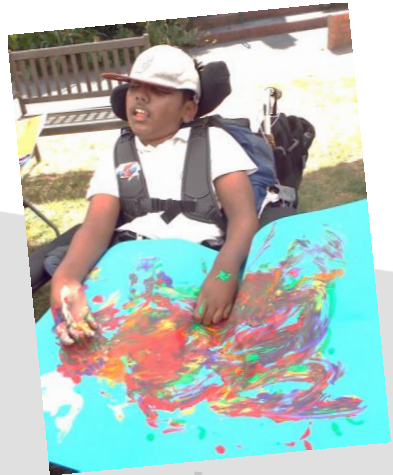
Educational and Social Outings.
